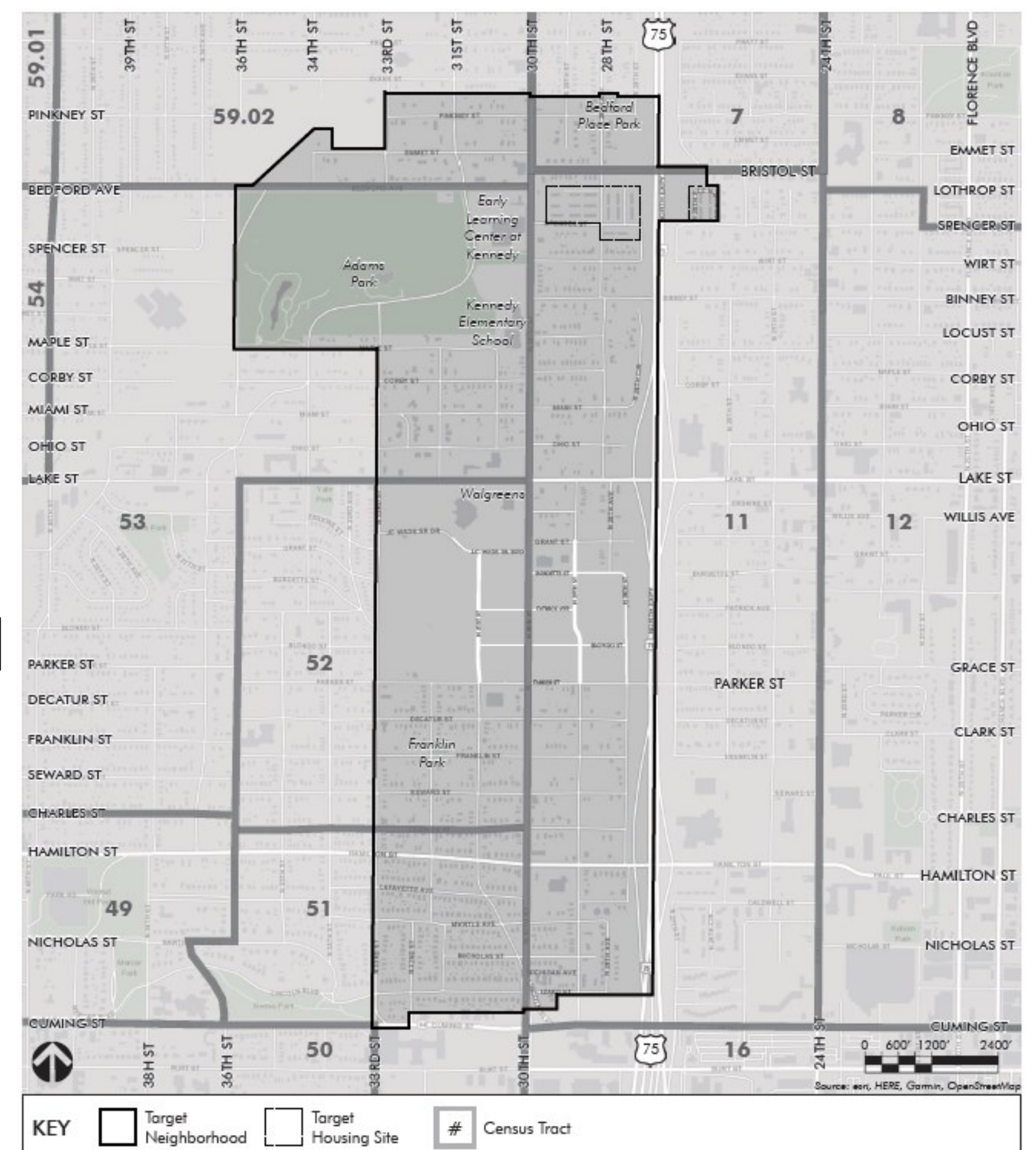


Choice Neighborhood and the Consolidated Plan

You may have heard that the City of Omaha and the Omaha Housing Authority received a \$25 million award for the North 30th Street Transformation Plan. Omaha is one of four cities to receive this award during this grant cycle. Along with the \$25 million it will bring to our community, it also leverages another \$157 million of local funds.

So what does this have to do with the Consolidated plan?

The draft Consolidated Plan must be revised to include CNI activities and funding. The City will ask HUD for an extension to complete the Consolidated Plan, provide for another public hearing, and submit the Consolidated Plan later in the summer.



What is presented in the draft Consolidated Plan will change. The changes will emphasize the North 30th Street corridor. Expected changes include the following:

- . The Five-Year Strategic Plan will focus on goals supporting the North 30th Street corridor.
- . The 2019 Action Plan will include projects that focus on the North 30th Street corridor.
- . We will continue to focus on the North and South NRSA's. The CNI target area may become an NRSA.
- . We will continue to focus on Neighborhood Action and Fact through 2020.

The City will send out notification when the revised Consolidated Plan is available for review.

Additional public hearings are required.
