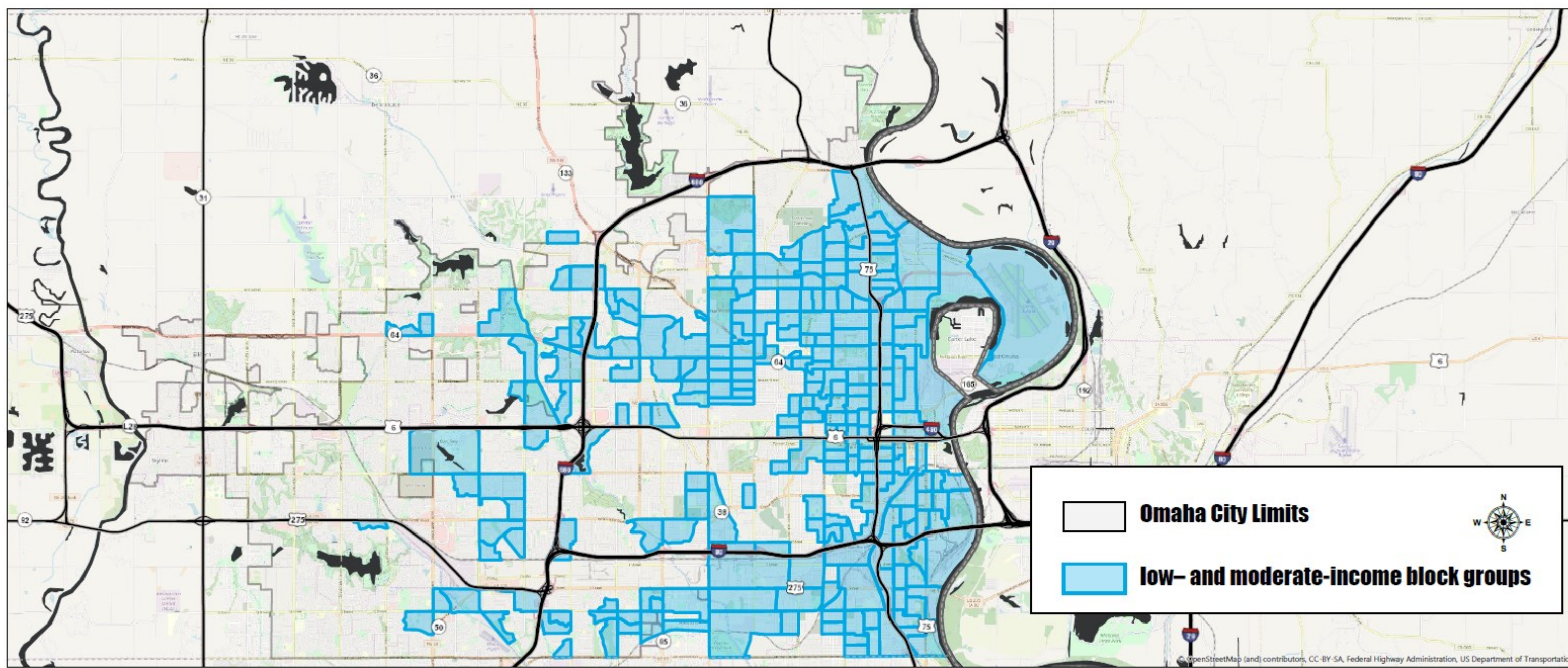
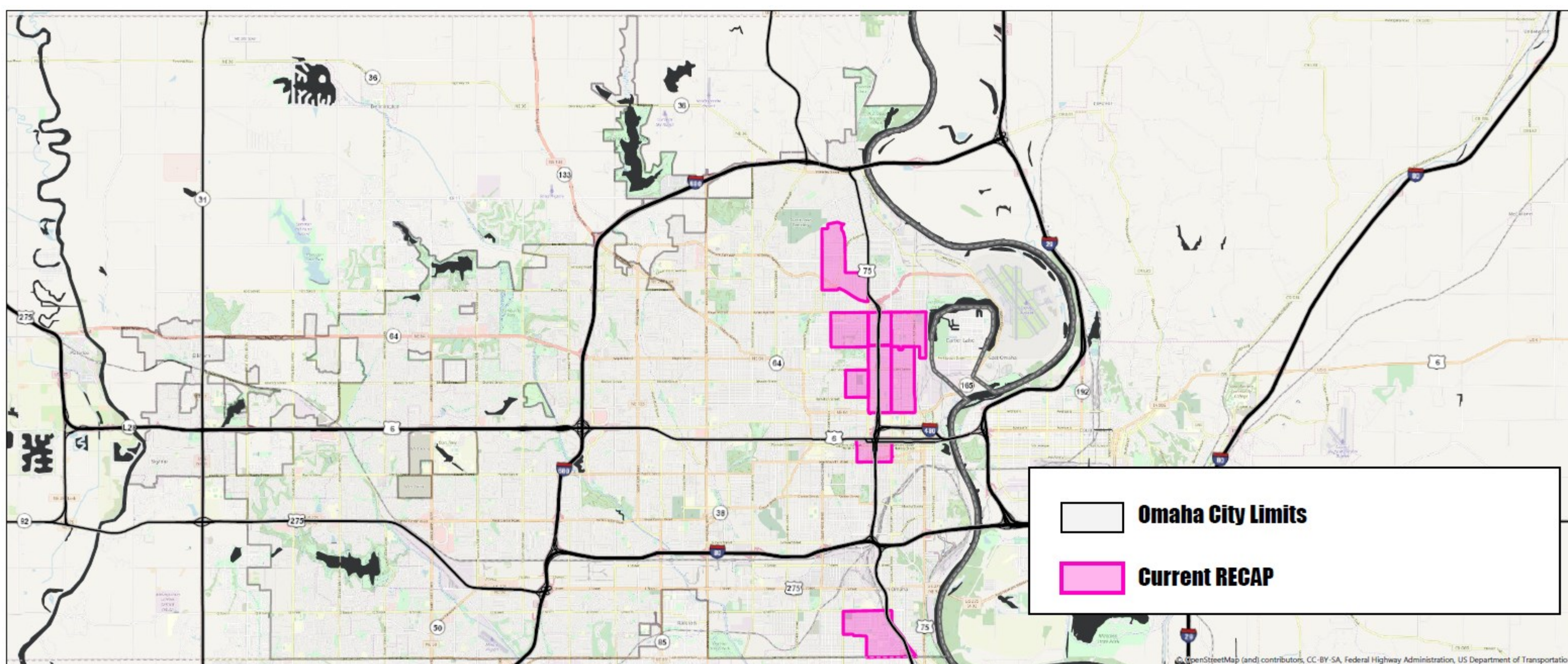


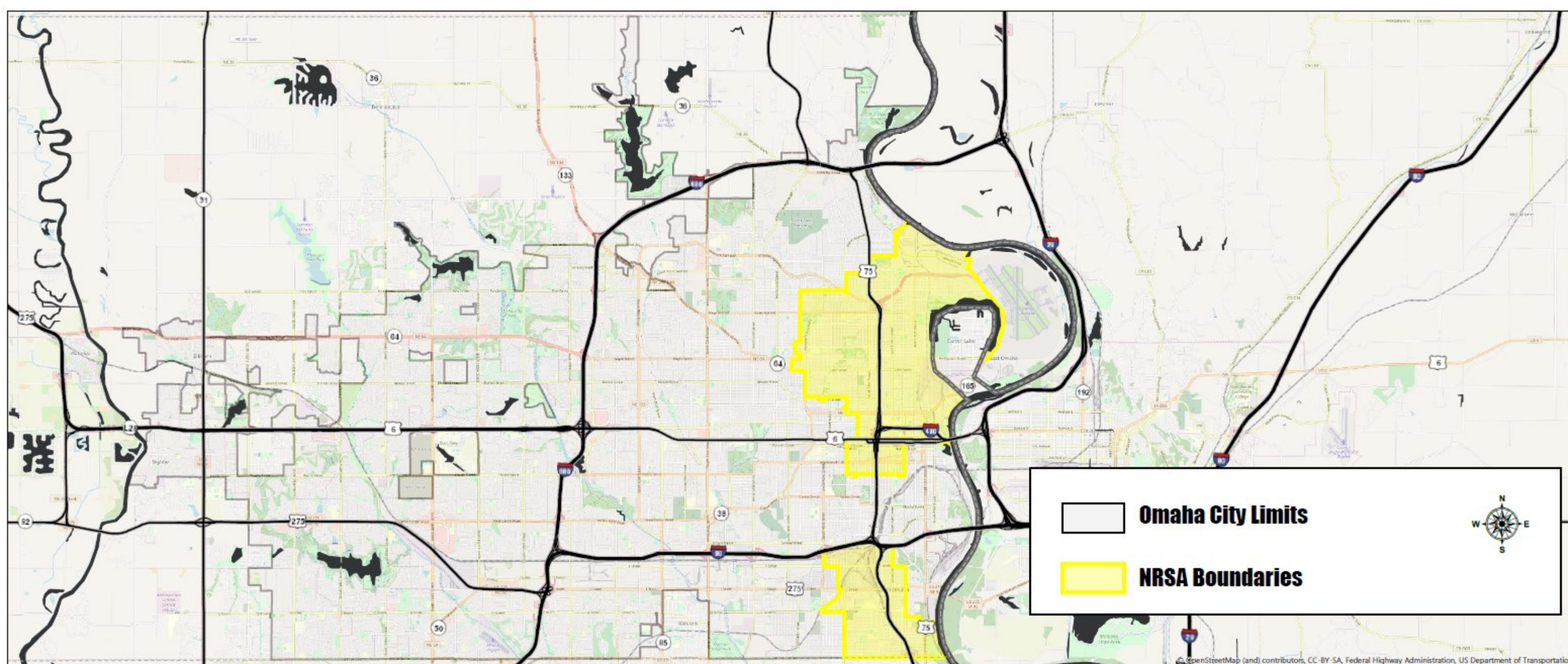
# Neighborhood Revitalization Strategy Areas



This map shows all of Omaha’s Low- and Moderate-Income Census Tract Block Groups. Are there more than you thought? Less? Does the location of the Block Groups surprise you? What other thoughts do you have?



This map shows the Racially/Ethnically Concentrated Areas of Poverty, or RECAPs. Most of the RECAPs are located in northeast Omaha. One is in midtown and another is in southeast Omaha. Many of the City’s CDBG funded programs focus on areas “east of 72nd Street” because all of the recaps fall within this area.



This map shows the current NRSA boundaries. Considering the information on this poster and the adjacent poster, what are your thoughts? Are the NRSA too big or too small? Do they capture the right areas? Should we have more NRSA? Less? Do the boundaries seem appropriate? What other thoughts do you have about the NRSA?
